I want to thank all of you who came out to vote on Monday, March 5th and those who thought about coming, but were not able to make it.

C. Lynn Barnes was elected to the vacant seat on the Town Council in a special election and one of her first duties was to provide the necessary 4th vote to re-suspend Myles Spires, Jr. from the Office of the Mayor. I know that we still have a way to go to get our Town Council and Office of the Mayor back to working for the citizens; however we are on the right track.

We still have an election on March 14th coming and at this time as you are all aware we will be electing someone to represent our town in Ward I for our regular election.

We will also vote on questions that were on the petition that was circulated in the early part of 2006, regarding changes to our Town Charter.

If you look at your sample ballot that was posted in the Forest Heights Newsletter, you will notice that some of the question is in italics and some in regular print and in parentheses; PLEASE READ THE QUESTION CAREFULLY ABOVE THE WRITING!!!! The italic writing is the way you want the charter to be changed to. The regular writing is the way the charter currently reads.

The one thing that I have consistently raised my voice for since December, 2005 is the RIGHT FOR THE CITIZENS OF FOREST HEIGHTS TO HAVE A VOICE IN OUR TOWN on these charter changes and the right to vote. Each person will vote their own conscience and will make the choice that they feel is good for the town. That is your RIGHT!

The only item I pray each of you will vote NO to is QUESTION #8 which asks if you want to remove the Code of Conduct. We need a code of conduct article in our charter as we have seen in the past months.
