

STATEMENT OF CANDIDACY

I, George E. McDermott, town resident of 43 years, local activist, announces his candidacy for a position on the town council. In the belief that happenings over the past two years involving the mayors and related council members who appear to working in lockstep with one another to dismantle our Constitution and By-laws and institute new laws and resolutions amending our town charter and disenfranchising our citizens of their right to proper representation and responsible leadership afforded under the town charter of our founders.
