ORDER OF COURT


Upon review of the Complaint for Temporary Restraining Order, and hearing an ex parte argument of counsel, the court finds that the Town of Forest Heights failed to comply with Article 23A, § 13 (g) and (h) of the Annotated Code of Maryland requiring it to review a timely filed (on 12/23/05) petition for a referendum on certain proposed amendments to the Forest Heights town charter.

It is this 6th day of January, 2006, by the Circuit Court for Prince George's County,

ORDERED, that the Town of Forest Heights is restrained from enforcing or acting on Charter Amendment Resolutions Nos. 3 through 13 proposing to amend the Forest Heights town charter Sections 33ff, as set forth in Plaintiff's Exhibit A attached herein. The court finds irreparable harm if this Order is not granted. It is further

ORDERED, that the Town of Forest Heights may apply for a nullification or dissolution of this Order upon two days notice and this Order shall expire on January 17, 2006. It is further

ORDERED that this Order shall be served forthwith on the Town of Forest Heights or its Resident Agent.
