ENACTED: February 5, 2007


WHEREAS, the Town Council purpose for establishing a fee for the filing of an application for the cable television franchise with the Town of Forest Heights; and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED the Ordinance Code of the Town of Forest Heights shall be modified by amending Section 6.11: Franchise Fee which reads:

The Town of Forest Heights is entitled to collect a franchise fee in such amount, as may be from time to time established by the Mayor and Town Council, for each franchise granted; and any application for a CATV franchise shall be accompanied by a non-refundable application fee in an amount no less than Five Thousand Dollars (\$5,000.00) to be used by the City to offset expenses incurred in the application evaluation and franchising process.

AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this resolution shall take effect 30 days after its passage and shall remain in effect indefinitely.


