My Fellow Residents:

Over the past few years, I have been asked by many of my fellow Forest Heights Residents to make a bid for another term as Mayor of our Town. These residents are well aware of the progress our town made during my previous tenure as Mayor:

2. We had a police force of eight officers which provided us 24 hour police coverage. This dramatically reduced crime.
